Miller & Chevalier client Kevin Dawes was the victim of torture at the hands of the Syrian regime. He was recently interviewed by Deborah Amos of *NPR News* regarding the horrific circumstances of his more than three years of detention and torture in a Syrian prison. Mr. Dawes detailed his ongoing struggles with the physical and mental aftermath of the torture he endured. In November, Miller & Chevalier sued Syria on behalf of Mr. Dawes in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia, for his false imprisonment and torture.
