ORDER RE-SETTING CALENDAR CALL AND TRIAL DATE


THIS MATTER came before the Court upon Defendant Carlos Rodriguez' Motion to Reset Trial Date (**D.E.#243**), filed July 30, 2010. In this motion, defendant Rodriguez asks the Court to reset the present trial date of December 6, 2010 to November 29, 2010. After careful consideration, and having reviewed the co-defendant's responses filed thereto, the Court finds that the ends of justice will be served by the setting of said trial as set forth below and that an extension outweighs the best interest of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial. Therefore, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Motion to Reset Trial Date is **Granted** **as to all defendants.** The previous trial date of December 6, 2010 and the call of the calendar of December 2, 2010 is CANCELLED. The above styled cause has been reset for Jury Trial for the two-week trial period commencing **November 22, 2010.** This trial shall commence on **Monday, November 29, 2010 at 9:30 a.m.** before the Honorable

Jose E. Martinez, United States District Judge, at the United States Courthouse,
courtroom 10-2, 400 N. Miami Avenue, Miami, Florida. Counsel shall report to Calendar
Call on **Thursday, November 18, 2010 at 1:30 p.m.**

The Court finds that the period of delay from **July 30, 2010 to November 29,**
2010, and any other trial date set hereafter excluded in calculating the period within
which trial must commence in accordance with the provisions of the Speedy Trial Act, 18
U.S.C. §3161,(h)(1)(F).
