Before the Court is Nominal Defendant Parker Drilling Company's ("Parker Drilling") motion to dismiss Plaintiffs' Amended Verified Consolidated Shareholder Derivative Petition (the "Amended Petition") and enforce the Court's prior order sustaining special exceptions. Defendant Parker Drilling Company's motion is joined by Defendants Robert L. Parker, Sr., Robert L. Parker, Jr., John W. Gibson, Jr., Robert E. McKee, III, Roger B. Plank, R. Rudolph Reinfrank, George J. Donnelly, Robert W. Goldman, Gary R. King, and David C. Mannon. Along with the previous rulings made by this Court requiring the Plaintiff to replead as well as the special exceptions granted, the Court also considered:
